### **Historical/Biographical Information**

American artist William R. Hutson was born on September 6, 1936, in San Marcos, TX. Hutson studied at the University of New Mexico, Albuquerque, NM; Los Angeles City College, Los Angeles, CA; Los Angeles Trade Technical College, Los Angeles, CA, and the San Francisco Academy of Art, San Francisco, CA. Hutson has been a guest speaker or visual arts educator at Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, LA; The University of Paris-Sorbonne Nouvelle, Paris, France; Ecole Nationale d' Art et Manufacture, Libreville, Gabon; Hunter College, City University of New York, New York, NY; The Detroit Institute of Arts, Detroit, MI; Maryland Institute College of Art and Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, MD; Ohio State University, Columbus, OH; The National Museum of Art, Lagos, Nigeria; Lalit Kala Akademy, the National Academy of Art, New Delhi, India and Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, India.

Throughout his career, Bill Hutson has been the recipient of numerous awards, including the Cassandra Foundation Award and a National Endowment for the Arts fellowship. Currently, the artist lives and works in Lancaster, Pennsylvania where he is the Jennie Brown Cook and Betsy Hess Cook Distinguished Artist-In-Residence, and Assistant Professor Emeritus of Art and Art History, at Franklin and Marshall College.

Hutson's work has been shown in solo exhibitions at numerous museums and galleries, including but not limited to the Phillips Museum of Art, Franklin and Marshall College, Lancaster, PA; Watson Gallery, Wheaton College, Norton, MA; Noel Fine Art Acquisitions, Charlotte, NC; Hub-Robeson Gallery, Pennsylvania State University, University Park, PA; Olmsted Gallery, Penn State University, Harrisburg, PA; Cinque Gallery, New York, NY; G. ### **Scope and Content Note**

This collection documents the professional career of contemporary African-American artist Bill Hutson. It contains personal materials relating to Bill Hutson's career as a fine artist and teacher. As a fine artist, these items include resumes, prizes, fellowships, exhibitions, interviews, images of artwork, personal photographs, and sales. As a teacher, items include C.V.s, employment histories, contracts, course syllabi, guest lectures, bibliographies, and curated exhibitions.

The bulk of the collection consists of exhibition materials (catalogs and announcements) collected by Bill Hutson from 1970 to 2010. These unique materials document the development of African-

American abstract art in the later half of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. In addition, the collection richly chronicles Bill Hutson's individual and group exhibitions over the course of five decades.

Contemporaries of Bill Hutson who are extensively chronicled in the collection include Edward Clark, Alvin Loving, Melvin Edwards, Sam Middleton, Howardena Pindell, Frank Bowling, Nanette Carter, Sam Gilliam, Joe Overstreet, Jack Whitten, Yvonne Pickering Carter, Richard Mayhew, William T. Series V includes slides of work in progress and finished artworks by Bill Hutson; images of people, places and events; and slides of work by other artists. Folders grouped under "Slide Boxes" comprise slides from slide boxes organized by Bill Hutson and were left in the groupings found in these boxes.
